***Villa Monastero, Varenna, Italy
September 12 - 15, 2011***

HOW TO GET TO VARENNA

Varenna is a small town on the east side of lake Como, on the railroad from Milano to Sondrio. It can be reached by train from Milano in approximately one hour (with a direct train). If you arrive by plane at either Linate or Malpensa airports you should go to Milano Central Station.

From Linate airport (<http://www.sea-aeroportimilano.it/en/>):

You can get the airport bus to Milan Central Station.

You can buy your train ticket at the "Ferrovie dello Stato" airport ticket office (ground floor, arrival lounge). Buses from and to Linate leave every 20 minutes from 8 a.m. to 7 p.m., every 30 minutes before 8 a.m. and after 7 p.m. The ride to the station takes approximately 20 minutes, depending on traffic conditions.

From Malpensa airport (<http://www.sea-aeroportimilano.it/en/>):

You can either take the blue bus or the train (choose the ones arriving in Milano Centrale Station).

You can also buy your train ticket to Varenna at the airport to avoid possible long queue at Milan Central Station.

Buses from and to Milan Central Station leave every 30 minutes from 8 a.m. to 13 p.m.; every 60 minutes from 14 p.m. to 18 p.m.; after 18 p.m. the buses leave at 18.30 p.m., 19.00 p.m., 20.00 p.m., 21.00 p.m. and 22.15 p.m. The ride to the station takes approximately 60 minutes.

Trains from and to Milano Centrale Station leave every 30 minutes and take about 40 minutes to arrive, avoiding any traffic problems.

For those that need to buy their ticket at Central Station, the ticket office is on ground level at the Station, while the platforms are on the upper level.

Remember to punch your ticket in one of the yellow punching machines before going on to the platform. To find the trains to Varenna look for the train bound to Sondrio-Tirano. All trains stop in Varenna.

From Orio al Serio airport (<http://www.sacbo.it/Airpor/portalProcess.jsp?languageID=2>):

You can take the shuttle-bus to reach Bergamo railway station.

The bus stop is outside the **ARRIVAL AREA** near the ticket vending machine. Tickets can be bought:

- Orio Shuttle Box – Arrival Area
- Turismo Bergamo – Arrival Area
- Ticket vending machine at the bus stop

Frequency of the buses: from 5.18 to 00.00.

You will reach Bergamo train station in 15 minutes.

From Bergamo train station you should take the train direction Lecco, and then change in this city and take the connection train to VARENNA (direction Sondrio-Tirano).

Time of travel: about 1 hour 30 minutes.

When you arrive in Varenna train station:

Participants arriving at the Varenna train station on Sunday, September 11, will find a shuttle bus connecting with the hotels. The shuttle will be at the station for the arrival of every train from Milano, from late morning to 10.30 p.m.

Pay attention: the shuttle charged of this service is the one holding a poster with the title of the conference.

At arrival only the shuttle service is free of charge.

For those who will come by car, some of the hotels have free parking places, others private parking (to be paid at the hotel). Moreover we have reserved some parking places near Villa Monastero for the participants to our workshop.

In case you want to use one of these places (untill they are available) you should come to secretariat and ask for the paper indicating that you are one of the participant and to put it in evidence on the car.

Registration to the workshop: at registration desk in Villa Monastero on Sunday from 3.00 p.m. to 7 p.m and on Monday morning starting from 8.00 a.m.
